Pudendal Neuralgia (PN) is a myofascial pelvic pain syndrome that often frustrates medical professionals and patients.

Common symptoms include burning, stabbing pain in the vagina, anus, perineum, and/or genitals, urinary urgency, frequency and pain, bowel dysfunction and sexual dysfunction.

Despite the apparent complexity of this disorder, PN can successfully be managed through a multidisciplinary approach with an emphasis on manual therapy.

This course will describe the evidence behind soft tissue techniques that are applicable for all patients with myofascial pelvic pain and students will return to their clinics with numerous, immediately-applicable treatments for patients with pelvic pain.

In addition, this course will discuss the range of medical interventions and surgeries currently utilized for PN. The
